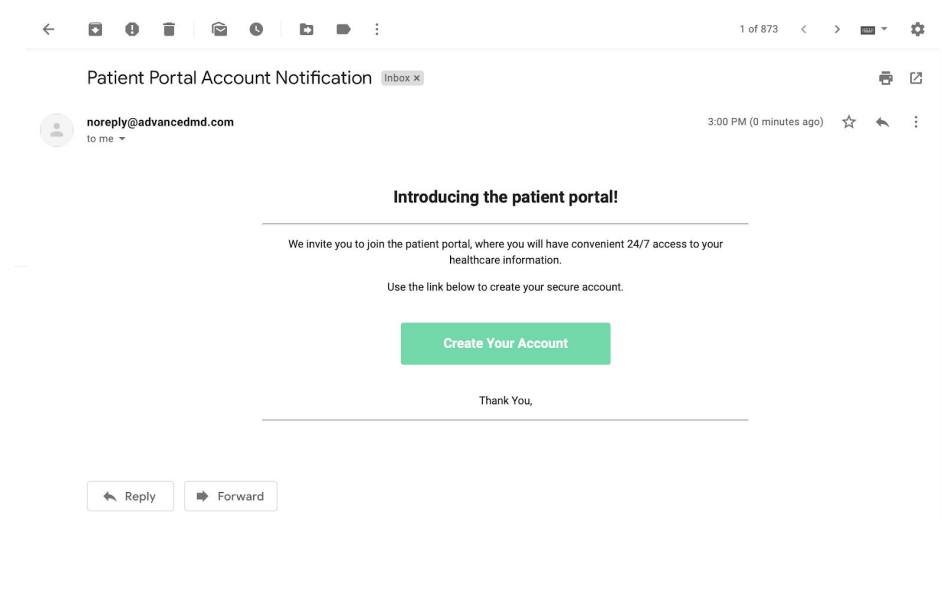
Step 2: Click "Register", or use Facebook or Google

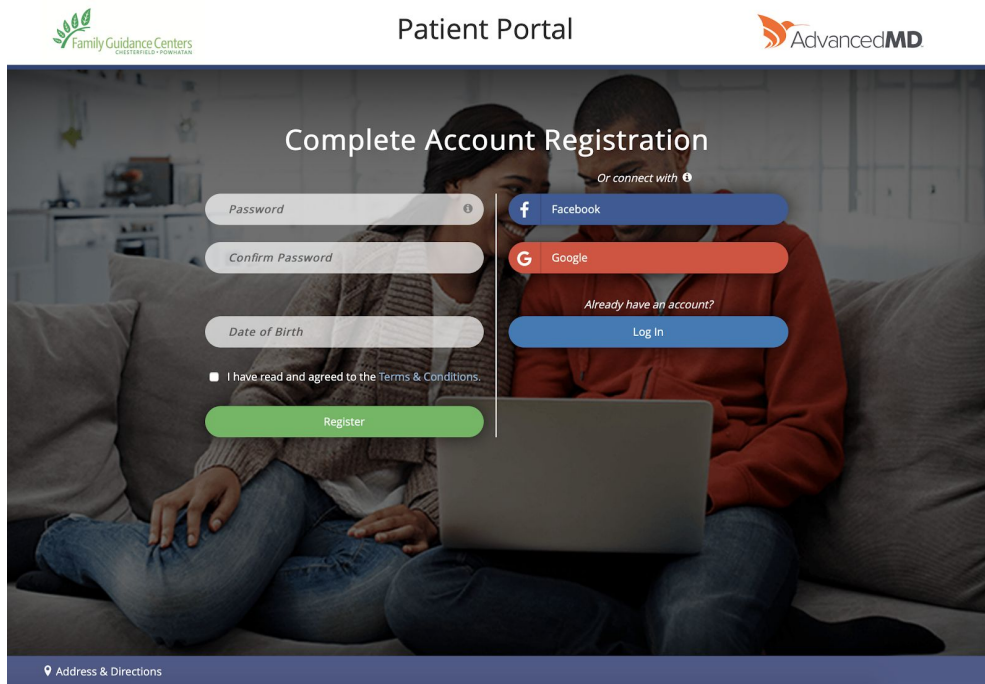
Step 3: Enter the patient’s first, last, and the email associated with the account. If you are the parent/guardian, enter the patient’s name, and make sure the email is what the office has. Then, click “Register”. It will send you an email to confirm their account.

Step 4: Click “create your account” in the email. It will open a screen on AdvancedMD to “complete account registration”. This is where create your password and enter your (or the patient’s) date of birth.
